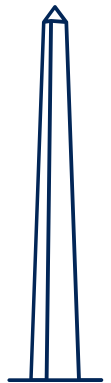
The White House used to be known as the "**President's Palace**" or the "**President's House**" until President Theodore Roosevelt officially named it the White House in 1901.
